



Conditions of Entry

SELECTION OF WORKS

The 2018 awards will be a two stage process. Approximately 60 works will be selected by John Parker from digital images. Selected artists will send the work to 148 Ferry Road, Clive, Hawkes Bay between Monday 15th - Friday 19th October 2018.

Due to the size of the CAN Gallery work is limited to ONE entry per artist and wall hanging is also limited and is at the discretion of CAN Gallery.

ENTRY PAYMENT

Entry Payment is \$25.00 and can be paid by Cheques to UKU Clay Hawkes Bay, 148 Ferry Road, Clive, Hawkes Bay, 4102 or Internet Banking to UKU Clay 06-0701-0506698-00 Ref (your name).

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All entrants must be a New Zealand resident.

All styles of work are acceptable providing work is predominantly made from clay. All entries must be the original work and concept of the entrant. The work must have been made in the last 12 months and not previously exhibited. One work from each artist, which may be a group/installation no larger than 1x1M. There is limited wall space for wall works.

Entry form to be completed and returned by emailed to upmuddycreek@xtra.co.nz or post to 148 Ferry Road, Clive, Hawkes Bay 4102, including up to 3 digital images of the work, by 5pm Friday 31st August 2018. Late entries will not be accepted.

Selector John Parker will select approximately 60 works for the exhibition from digital images supplied. His decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding his selection. UKU Clay and Selector reserve the right to withdraw from the exhibition any work conceded to be significantly different from submitted images.

Entrants will be notified on Monday 8th October 2018 and selected works need to be then sent to 148 Ferry Road, Clive, Hawkes Bay, 4102. Receiving dates between Monday 15th - Thursday 18th October 2018. Local Hawkes Bay entries may be hand delivered. Please phone first to arrange a time.

Packaging must be suitable and reusable to return unsold works, clearly labelled with entrants name and return address. While all due care will be taken with every aspect of the exhibition, insurance of the work remains the responsibility of the entrant. Unsold work will be returned by courier at UKU Clay's expense at the conclusion of the exhibition.

UKU Clay and CAN Gallery reserves the right to photograph and reproduce selected work for publications, promotion and archival purposes. All personal information gathered for this exhibition will remain confidential.

All works must be for sale and a commission of 30% will be charged on all sales by CAN Gallery.

While all due care will be taken with every aspect of the exhibition, insurance of the work, while on display, remains the responsibility of the entrant.
